DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

"An Award for Distinguished Service to the ACC in Matters other than Mountaineering"

The Distinguished Service Award was instituted in 1970. The form of this award is a gold ACC pin accompanied by a wood and brass plaque describing the award.

The Distinguished Service Award is presented to members of The Alpine Club of Canada (ACC) who have given outstanding service to the ACC either on a voluntary basis or exceeding the value of their remuneration for a period of at least five years in **two** or more of the following areas:

- toward furthering the aims of the ACC, or
- on a committee or project of the Club* or Section, or,
- in providing leadership of a large undertaking for the Club or Section, or,
- towards the activities of the Club or a Section.

Nominations for this award are made by any ACC member in writing on the specified nomination form to the Awards Committee via The Alpine Club of Canada **no later than December 31st**. The Awards Committee will evaluate and present the submitted nominations to the Board of Directors prior to the spring Annual General Meeting (AGM). The successful nominees must have a favourable vote of not less than three-quarters of the voting members of the Board. Award recipients will receive their award at the spring AGM or in some other suitable manner.

- b) on a committee or project of the Club* or Section, or
- c) in providing leadership of a large undertaking of the Club or Section, or
- d) towards the activities of the Club or a Section.
