

Kokanee Cabin Lottery Timeline and Rules

Kokanee Lottery Opening and Closing

Lottery opens Apr. 19, 2010 Close May 19th 2010 at noon MST

Winners along with second and third backups to be notified by email no later than May 26th. Only winners and runner-ups will be contacted.

Winners deposit deadline is June 8th at noon MST.

-Any weeks not secured by winners will be made available to the first runner up by noon MST on June 10th. First runner up deposit deadline is due June 17th at noon MST.

- Any weeks not secured by the first runner up will be made available to the second runner up winners no later than June 18th.

Second runner up winners deposit deadline is due June 24th noon MST

- All space not secured through winners and backups will be available for general booking on June 30th, 2010 at 9:30am Mountain time.

Lottery Rules/Logistical Details:

-Stay length is 7 nights with the first night on Saturday and the last night on a Friday (leaving Saturday morning)

-Lottery applications can be for any weeks starting January 8th with the final week available for application April 23rd

-Applicants must enter the lottery in groups of 12

-Application fee is \$15.00 for every week applied. Multiple applications can be made.

-The only way to apply for the lottery is to use the online system

-A winner for each week will be selected along with a second and third runner up.

-Rates for ski weeks are \$875. per person and include 7 nights accommodation and return flights.

-All gear, food and any other items being flown on the helicopter may be weighed at staging area. The weight limit for items (other than people) is **100lbs** per person.

-We encourage all groups that are successful in the lottery to limit 'bulk' when packing. Please pack gear and food accordingly considering that gear, food and 12 people need to fit on 3 helicopter flights.

-The winning applicant in the lottery will be considered the week's group leader and will be the liaison between the group and the Alpine Club of Canada. The winning applicant will also be responsible for making all deposits and final payments. All payments once made are non refundable.

-At time of booking a 20% Non-refundable deposit is due, Final payment is due 90 days prior to departure. Please read our cancellation and payment policy.

-If you are traveling with a guide or cook you have to include them in your group size.

- Traveling in the backcountry area is for advance intermediate and advance/expert skiers with backcountry experience.

-All trips are self-guided and self catered

Payment and Cancellation Policy:

Payment: At time of booking a 20% non-refundable deposit is required. Final payment is due 90 days prior to trip departure. Credit cards accepted are Master Card or Visa. The credit card on file will automatically be charged on or before due date. We accept payment by cheque but must have a credit card on file. Final payment by cheque must be received prior or on due date. The Club reserves the right to cancel your booking and retain all payments made should we not receive a cheque on final due date. All payments are to be made by the trip leader in one bulk sum. We will not accept individual payment. Pricing is subject to change without notice.

Cancellation: All payments once made are 100% non refundable. Cancellations should be submitted in writing by the trip leader only. Any trips missed due to inclement weather or travel and flight delays or cancellations are non refundable. The Alpine Club of Canada reserves the right to cancel any trip. Any days missed due to inclement weather or any other reasons beyond our control are non refundable. Dates are non transferable in the event of a cancellation.

Emergency Evacuation: In the event of an incident that may require evacuation, any and all members of a group evacuated are responsible for all cost associated with the evacuation(s).

NOTE: The Alpine Club of Canada strongly recommends that you purchase **Trip Cancellation/Trip Interruption Insurance** to protect your investment. We sell Trip Cancellation & Trip Interruption Insurance using **Travel Underwriters**, which provides coverage and benefits toward a variety of pre-paid and unexpected travel expenses. Weight restrictions apply. If standard helicopter flights cannot be completed due to the group is over the allowable weight. The group or individuals are responsible to cover the cost of the extra flight. You may be asked to leave gear behind if your group is over the weight restriction.
