<p>KOKANEE CREEK GIBSON LAKE TO KOKANEE LAKE TO KASLO LAKE TO SLOCAN CHIEF CABIN</p> <p>\$25.00 cabin fee \$10.00 tenting fee</p>	<p>Kokanee Glacier Road to Gibson Lake parking lot</p> <p><b>Kokanee Glacier Rd. open to Gibson Lake trailhead</b></p> <p><b>10.7.06 - &lt; 100cm snow at cabin</b></p>	<p>Snow covered beginning at Kokanee Lake – winter windfall / avalanche debris to be expected. Summer trail along Kokanee Lake is still obscured by snow for 2/3 of the traverse. Hikers should use extreme caution negotiating this area of the trail, and it is not recommended to try and follow the usual summer route above Kokanee Lake at this time. Beyond the North end of Kokanee Lake, the summer trail is completely obscured by snow to the cabin, where there is approximately one meter of snow still on the ground.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4 km (2 hrs) to Kok. Open to trailhead</b></p> <p><b>10.07.06 – &lt; 100cm snow at cabin</b></p>	<p>Snow covered from approximately 1900m – winter windfall removed. Some bridges are slippery – use caution.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Moderate, 8 km, 4 hours, elevation gain: 762 metres, trailhead elevation: 1321 meters. The 8 person cabin, built in 1984, is located north of Woodbury Glacier with a tenting area nearby</li> </ul>
<p>SILVER SPRAY CABIN \$25.00 cabin fee \$10.00 tenting fee</p>		<p>Snow covered from 1900m – winter windfall removed.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The 10 person cabin, built in 1994, is located south of Sunrise Mountain with a tenting area nearby. <b>Note: propane is currently unavailable – visitors advised to bring backpack stove for cooking purposes.</b></li> </ul>
SUNSET LAKE		Not cleared, winter windfall on trails.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4.5 km (1.5 hrs) easy hike on road to reach trail</li> <li>Trail not cleared of windfall</li> <li>Pretty sub-alpine lake, good fishing.</li> <li>Camping and fires <b>NOT</b> permitted</li> </ul>

To Joker Millsite, easy road.</li> <li>3.5 km (2 hrs) Joker Millsite to Helen Deane Lake, elevation gain 452 m, moderate – steep hike.</li> </ul>

LEMON CREEK		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>NOT Maintained</li> <li>NOT Patrolled</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>10 km (5 hrs) to Sapphire Lks., elevation gain 950m, sections of trail washed out and headwall difficult to locate.</li> <li>Sapphire Lakes camping prohibited.</li> </ul>
